: **AGREED PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION**

This matter is before the Court upon the Plaintiffs’ Motion for Temporary Restraining Order and Preliminary Injunction (Doc. No. 3) and upon agreement of the parties. In light of the parties agreement to the entry of this preliminary injunction, the Court, having conducted a conference with counsel on September 14, 2010, finds the motion to be well-taken and therefore, it is hereby ORDERED, DECREED and ADJUDGED that:

(1) the Defendants their agents and employees, or another other person, agency or organization acting in concert with or at the behest or direction of the Defendants, ARE HEREBY ENJOINED from prohibiting or otherwise interfering or restricting the Plaintiffs and those associated with the Plaintiffs from utilizing the Andover Public Square on September 17, 2010;

(2) the Defendants their agents and employees, or another other person, agency or organization acting in concert with or at the behest or direction of the Defendants, ARE HEREBY ENJOINED prohibiting or otherwise interfering or restricting the Plaintiffs and those associated with the Plaintiffs from utilizing the Andover Public Square on dates in the future;

(3) the Defendants their agents and employees, or another other person, agency or organization acting in concert with or at the behest or direction of the Defendants, ARE HEREBY ENJOINED from taking any actions to enforce or require compliance by any individual, organization or group with Andover Township Resolution 06-104.

In light of the great public interest being served by the issuance of this injunction, *i.e.*, vindication and protection of rights guaranteed by the First Amendment, the Court expressly waives the requirement for security pursuant to Fed. Civ. R. 65(c).

This preliminary injunction shall remain in effect until further order of the Court.
